By the Assistant Chief, Audio Division:

1. In response to a Petition for Rule Making filed by NM Licensing LLC ("Petitioner"), the Audio Division has before it a *Notice of Proposed Rule Making*¹ proposing the reallocation of Channel 248C2, Station KLAQ(FM) from Durant, Oklahoma, to Whitewright, Texas, as Whitewright's first local aural transmission service. On the date for filing comments, Petitioner filed a request for dismissal of its proposal to reallocate Channel 248C2 to Whitewright, Texas.² No other comments were received.

2. A showing of continuing interest is required before a channel will be allotted. It is the Commission's policy to refrain from making an allotment to a community absent an expression of interest. Therefore, we will grant Petitioner's request to dismiss the instant proposal.

3. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, That the Petition for Rule Making filed by NM Licensing LLC IS DISMISSED.

4. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That this proceeding IS TERMINATED.
