

Incompatible useage in the 2.4ghz ISM band is intolerable. 802.11b/g wireless lan networks can not co-exist with Voice Phone use in the same signal space... We now depend on 802.11g wireless networking for business usage in the home. Having the Network "TOTALLY" shut down when a neighbor makes a phone call is terrible. These CHEAP 2.4ghz phones impact shared use of 2.4ghz channels for multiple concurrent wireless lan(DATA) users. It is like haveing a FOG HORN go off in a CONCERT seting. One user abuses all in range. YOU MUST STOP 2.4ghz ISM channels 1-11 being used for VOICE USAGE..This creates conflicts in the harmony of residential communities that is not resolveable by residents.
