Dear Ms. Dortch

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 76.503(g), Comcast Corporation ("Comcast") hereby notifies the Commission that it anticipates that it will acquire approximately 30,000 subscribers on or about April 30, 2004 from US Cable of Coastal, Texas, LP ("US Cable") serving subscribers in Georgia and South Carolina.¹

Since Comcast is currently attributed with all of the subscribers in the systems being acquired from US Cable, and also is currently (and will continue to be post-transaction) attributed with all of the subscribers affiliated with US Cable. Therefore, the above transaction will have no effect on the number of MVPD subscribers attributed to Comcast nationwide. Thus, based on available data, and assuming the most conservative interpretation of the Commission's current attribution rules, Comcast estimates that prior to this transaction it was attributed with 26,239,152 MVPD subscribers,² (or approximately 28.9% of all MVPD subscribers) and after this transaction it will be attributed with the same approximately 26,239,152 MVPD subscribers.

¹ As described herein, the acquisition of these subscribers will not change the number subscribers currently attributed to Comcast because these subscribers are already attributed to Comcast. On March 23, 2004, an application to acquire two business radio licenses associated with the transaction was filed with the Commission. This application for consent to assignment was granted on March 31, 2004.


² This figure for Comcast subscribers is based on Comcast's semi-annual subscriber certification letter filed with the Commission on March 22, 2004.
