THE WALT DISNEY COMPANY TO THE COMMENT OF THE HOME RECORDING  
RIGHTS COALITION ON PETITIONS FOR RECONSIDERATION**

The Motion Picture Association of America, Inc., Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer Studios Inc., Paramount Pictures Corporation, Sony Pictures Entertainment Inc., Twentieth Century Fox Film Corporation, Universal City Studios LLLP, and The Walt Disney Company (the “MPAA Parties”) submit this reply to the Comment filed by the Home Recording Rights Coalition (“HRRC”) in response to the petitions for reconsideration filed by the MPAA Parties and the National Cable & Telecommunications Association (“NCTA”).<sup>1</sup>

No parties other than HRRC filed comments or oppositions in response to the petitions for reconsideration. Furthermore, HRRC “does not oppose the result sought by the [NCTA] and the [MPAA Parties].” There being no opposition to the petitions for reconsideration, the Commission should grant the requested relief and restore the words it deleted from the definition




