COMMENTS

Calvary Chapel of Montrose ("Calvary Chapel"), by and through its attorneys, hereby submits these Comments in support of the reservation of Channel 270C2, Olathe, Colorado, for noncommercial use. Calvary Chapel submitted a Petition for Rulemaking on November 21, 2003, in response to the *Public Notice*⁷ establishing a filing window for reserving existing, vacant commercial FM allotments. On March 26, 2004, the FCC released a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking proposing the reservation of the allotment for NCE use.⁸

As noted in the Petition, the reservation of the allotment would deliver 4,453 persons their first NCE service, 4,053 persons their second NCE service, and would best serve the public interest. Calvary Chapel continues to support this allotment, and intends to file an application for the allotment should the Commission reserve the allotment for NCE use.


