O R D E R


This is an action wherein BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., is challenging a decision of the Georgia Public Service Commission regarding its DSL service. BellSouth is also challenging that decision before the Federal Communications Commission. BellSouth has moved for a stay of this action, pending a ruling by the FCC [Doc. No. 24].

BellSouth's motion is not opposed by the defendants. Therefore, all further proceedings in this action are STAYED pending a final, non-appealable determination by the FCC. This stay does not affect the enforceability of the Georgia Public Service Commission's ruling.

The clerk is directed to close this case statistically. Once there has been a final, non-appealable ruling by the FCC

any party may notify the court, and the court will re-activate the case.
