The LPFM dream of Pastor Larry Soles is coming to an end after three years. He prevailed in an MX situation [a competition, for the same frequency, between mutually exclusive LPFM applications] and got reinstated after an accidental dismissal. Now a full power [radio station] has a CP [Construction Permit] modification which will wipe him out. The full power [radio station] is getting the *only* opportunity left in the Charlotte market.

We earnestly wish that LPFM had primary status [which would protect it from being subject to displacement by full power radio stations which are newly arrived, upgrading and/or relocating].

My point is that our nation rightly cares for what is happening in Iraq, but few will mourn the loss of an LPFM CP or license.
