Pursuant to Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's rules, Verizon Wireless, by its attorney, hereby notifies the Commission that on May 27, 2004, the following individuals held a telephone discussion with Chairman Michael K. Powell; Bryan N. Tramont, Chief of Staff; Sheryl J. Wilkerson, Legal Advisor; and John A. Rogovin, General Counsel: Dennis Strigl, President and CEO of Verizon Wireless; and William P. Barr, Executive Vice President and General Counsel of Verizon Communications.

Verizon Wireless emphasized its well-documented views on the legal risks associated with Commission adoption of the Consensus Plan, particularly in a manner that involves a private sale of spectrum to Nextel. Verizon Wireless also discussed other alternatives to the Consensus Plan set forth in the docket, including CTIA's April 29, 2004 proposal.
