We discussed the NTCA and OPASTCO comments in the above docket. NTCA and OPASTCO stated that their overriding concerns are (1) that the Commission require the payment of access charges by all carriers that utilize the public switched network; (2) that the Commission's policies allow rural ILECs to recover the cost of the underlying facilities utilized in the provision of broadband; (3) that the Commission use the full extent of its authority to ensure that universal service is adequately funded; and (4) that the Commission employ regulatory parity in applying public safety, disability access, and other social obligations to VoIP providers and other carriers of traditional voice services.
