Dear Mr. Tucker:

This is in response to your request dated February 24, 2004, filed on behalf of Reunion Broadcasting L.L.C. (Reunion) for a waiver and refund of the late charge penalty for late payment of the fiscal year (FY) 2003 regulatory fee for Station KMUR(AM). Our records reflect that you paid the FY 2003 regulatory fee of \$600.00 and the \$150.00 late charge penalty for late payment of the regulatory fee, for a total payment of \$750.00.

You state that “[w]hile Reunion is the present licensee of KMUR, it was not the licen[s]ee at the time this fee was due and payable.” You state (and the Commission records confirm) that “[t]he transfer into Reunion was not approved until October 23, 2003 . . . [and that t]he transfer was consummated on November 23, 2003.” You state that because Reunion was “not the licensee at the time this fee became payable, the responsibility for its payment rests with the prior licensee.” You state that you are paying the total amount due for FY 2003 (but are requesting a waiver and refund of the late charge penalty) because Reunion has “the ability to offset the unpaid fee against certain post closing payments due the prior licensee.”

The record reflects that Reunion was not the licensee of Station KMUR(AM) at the time the FY 2003 fee payment obligation attached, i.e., on or before October 1, 2002. Although the license was subsequently assigned to Reunion, it was also not the licensee at the time the FY 2003 regulatory fee was due (i.e., September 25, 2003). We therefore find that Reunion was not responsible for the payment of the regulatory fee or the late charge penalty for late payment of the regulatory fee.¹ We therefore grant your request

for a refund of the \$150.00 late charge penalty. Although Reunion was not responsible for the FY 2003 regulatory fee, it has paid the FY 2003 regulatory fee for Station KMUR(AM) and does not request a refund thereof.²


Ladies and Gentlemen:

By letter dated February 13, 2004 we received a bill for an unpaid regulatory fee for KMUR AM, plus 25% penalty. While Reunion is the present licensee of KMUR, it was not the licensee at the time this fee was due and payable. The transfer into Reunion was not approved until October 23, 2003 (BAL 20030815AEF). The transfer was consummated on November 23, 2003.

Since we were not the licensee at the time this fee became payable, the responsibility for its payment rests with the prior licensee. However, we have the ability to offset the unpaid fee against certain post closing payments due the prior licensee. As a result, payment is enclosed.

It is likely that our payment of this fee will save you the expense of collection activity against the prior licensee. Under the circumstances, we are asking for a waiver of the late charge and request that it be refunded.
