**Re: Errata: American Cable Association's ("ACA") ex parte presentation in Section 706 Inquiry, GN Docket No. 04-54**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On June 4, 2004, ACA submitted an ex parte presentation in the above-referenced docket. We regret that the presentation contained two errors related to Mediacom Communications on page 5. In its June 4, 2004 letter, ACA reported that Mediacom serves 1.2 million subscribers and provides 85% of those subscribers access to broadband services. In fact, Mediacom serves 1.5 million subscribers and provides 96% of its subscribers with access to its broadband services. Therefore, the paragraph describing Mediacom should read:

**Mediacom Communications.** The Commission is familiar with the Mediacom success story. ACA's largest member, founded in 1995 by former Cablevision Industries executive Rocco Commisso, has grown to serve more than 1.5 million cable subscribers, predominantly in smaller markets. Mediacom has executed an aggressive plan to interconnect hundreds of rural systems and deliver broadband and advanced services company-wide. As a result, more than 96% of Mediacom's customers have access to broadband services, including those in communities like Red Oak, IA (pop. 6,197), Eagle Grove, IA (pop. 3,712), and Eddyville, IA (pop. 1,064).

We are sorry for any confusion these errors may have caused. Please include the corrected information in the record in the Section 706 proceeding.
