This letter is filed in accordance with Commission rules. On June 9, 2004, Wendy Thompson Fast of Consolidated Telephone Company and I met with Daniel Gonzalez, senior legal advisor to FCC Commissioner Martin and Jason B. Williams, special assistant to Commissioner Martin.

On the same day, Craig Aman of HunTel Systems, Wendy Thompson Fast of Consolidated Telephone Company, Charlie Cooper of Telec Consulting Resources, Michael Urdahl of Great Plains Communications and I met with Scott Bergman, Legal Advisor to FCC Commissioner Adelstein, in the above docket. We presented the Alliance for Rational Intercarrier Compensation's views on various issues related to intercarrier compensation reform.

In addition, we presented the FACTS (Fair Affordable Comprehensive Telecom Solution) Plan to address intercarrier compensation reform in concert with local rate rebalancing, unified Subscriber Line Charges and supplemental USE. The FACTS Plan also recommends compensation and regulation needs in an IP environment. A copy of the presentation is attached to this filing.
