On April 15, 2004, Cisco Systems, Inc. ("Cisco") representative Mary Brown and Information Technology Industry Council representative Joshua Rosenberg met with FCC staff Karen Rackley, Hugh Van Tuyl, Geraldine Matisse, Alan Scrimme, and Ron Repasi to discuss the above-captioned docket.

Attached is a copy of a short presentation given to staff. We stated that the equipment makers are very interested in promptly concluding the pending reconsideration in this docket. Of chief interest is the proposal to amend section 2.1077 of the Commission's rules so that the text of the Declaration of Conformity may be provided to users in the same manner and form as user information provided pursuant to Part 15. Specifically, manufacturers would like the opportunity to provide the text of the Declaration of Conformity via the Internet in circumstances where user information is provided over the Internet.
