Dear Mr. Moskowitz:

I am writing in response to the petition for rulemaking, filed August 20, 2003, on behalf of your client, Keymarket Licenses, LLC. The petition requests reallocation of Channel 282B from East Liverpool, Ohio, to Moon Township, Pennsylvania, and modification of the license of Radio Station WOGF(FM) accordingly.

Your client has proposed allotment of Channel 282B to Moon Township, Pennsylvania, at a restricted site with coordinates 40-30-56 NL and 80-24-34 WL, a location that is 15.9 KM (9.9 miles) west of the city reference coordinates for Moon Township and 8.0 kilometers south of the current location. Our engineering analysis shows that the reallocation of Channel 282B at the proposed site would increase WOGF(FM)'s short-spacing to WPGB(FM), Channel 284B, at Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, by approximately 2.8 kilometers. Section 73.207 of the Commission's Rules requires that petitions to amend the Table of Allotments meet all of the minimum distance separation requirements of that section.

Traditionally, the Commission's policy is to grant no waivers of the spacing requirements in considering the allotment of an FM channel. Although the Commission has created a limited exception to the rule, allowing us to waive the rule for petitions that would decrease an existing short-spacing, we cannot consider a proposal that would exacerbate an existing short-spacing. For the reason stated above, we are returning your petition for rule making as unacceptable for filing.

Your client may resubmit its petition, provided that the petition is amended either to comply with the requirements of Section 73.207 of the Commission's rules.





PETITION FOR RULEMAKING

Keymarket Licenses LLC, ("Keymarket") by its counsel, and pursuant to Section 303 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, hereby requests that the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC" or "Commission") amend Section 73.202(b) of the Commission's Rules to reallocate Channel 282B from East Liverpool, Ohio to Moon Township, Pennsylvania, as that community's first local service and modify the license of Radio Station WOGF(FM) accordingly. In support thereof, the following is respectfully shown:

1. Keymarket is the licensee of Radio Station WOGF(FM), East Liverpool, Ohio, which is licensed to operate on Channel 282B. The instant petition proposes to reallocate Channel 282B from East Liverpool, Ohio to Moon Township, Pennsylvania. As indicated by the attached Engineering Statement of William J. Getz of Carl T. Jones Corporation, full service Radio Station WOHI(AM), operating on 1490 kHz will continue to be licensed to and provide full service to East Liverpool, Ohio.

2. Moon Township, Pennsylvania is located in Allegheny County, Pennsylvania and was founded in 1788. Moon Township had a 2000 U.S. Census population of 22,290 persons and has its own boundaries. The township has an elected five member council which appoints

the township manager. Moon Township provides police, fire, water, and sewage services to the community. Moreover, Moon Township has its own school district which consists of three elementary schools, a middle school and a high school. Moon Township has numerous churches of various denominations, and various charitable organizations and clubs. Moon Township has its own post office and zip code, i.e., 15108, and its own cable TV channel. Moon Township is the home of several large employers, such as GlaxoSmith/Kline and Federal Express Ground, and part of Pittsburgh International Airport located in the Township. Moon Township also has numerous retail establishments including pharmacies, restaurants, etc. (See Exhibit 1 attached for information regarding Moon Township, Pennsylvania). Moon Township, therefore, has the social, economic and governmental indices to qualify as a community for allotment purposes. FM Channel Assignments (Biltmore Forest, North Carolina) 63 RR 2d 251 (1987). However, no AM or FM stations are currently licensed to Moon Township, either commercial or non-commercial. Consequently, the reallocation of Channel 282B to Moon Township will constitute the community's first local service.

3. Furthermore, full-service Radio Station WOHI(AM) will remain as a facility licensed to East Liverpool, Ohio, and will continue to serve the community. Consequently, the proposed reallocation of Channel 282B from East Liverpool, Ohio to Moon Township, Pennsylvania, and the modification of WOGF(FM)'s license will not leave East Liverpool bereft of local service.

4. The proposed reallocation complies with the Commission's Rules and would serve the Commission's allotment priorities and public interest. In Amendment of the Commission's Rules Regarding Modification of FM and TV and Authorizations to Specify a New Community of License, 4 FCC Rcd. 4870 (1989), recons. granted in part, 5 FCC Rcd. 7094 (1990), the

Commission stated that the proposed channel must be mutually exclusive with the existing channel and the new community must be preferred over the existing community under the Commission's allotment priorities. Since we are proposing the reallocation of the Channel 282B from East Liverpool, Ohio to Moon Township, Pennsylvania, the proposal is mutually exclusive with the current use of Channel 282B.

5. Further, the new community, Moon Township, will obtain a first local service whereas East Liverpool, Ohio will still be provided service by an AM station. Under the Commission's allotment criteria, a first local service is preferred over additional local services. See Revision of FM Assignment Policies and Procedures, 90 FCC 2d 88 (1982).


6. The relocation of Channel 282B to Moon Township from East Liverpool, Ohio will provide significant public service benefits. As indicated by the attached Engineering Statement, the proposal will extend new 60 dBu service to an additional 19,546 persons. Additionally, the proposal would improve WOGF(FM)'s (1) existing grandfathered shortspacing to first adjacent WQAL(FM), Cleveland, Ohio, by 5.88 kilometers and (2) the existing grandfathered shortspacing to first adjacent WQKT(FM), Wooster, Ohio by 2.66 kilometers. Finally, as indicated, Moon Township must be preferred for a first local service.

7. Petitioner hereby states that should the Commission grant the instant proposal to reallocate Channel 282B from East Liverpool, Ohio to Moon Township and modify the license of Radio Station WOGF(FM) accordingly, Petitioner will file an application for the new facility and will implement the application expeditiously.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Keymarket Licenses, LLC respectfully requests that the Commission amend its Table of Allotments to reallocate Channel 282B from East Liverpool, Ohio to Moon Township, Pennsylvania, and modify the license of Radio Station WOGF(FM), East Liverpool, Ohio, accordingly.

**STATEMENT OF WILLIAM J. GETZ
IN SUPPORT OF A PETITION TO AMEND
THE FM TABLE OF ALLOTMENTS**

I am a Radio Engineer, an employee in the firm of Carl T. Jones Corporation with offices located in Springfield, Virginia. My education and experience are a matter of record with the Federal Communications Commission.

This office has been authorized by Keymarket Licenses LLC, licensee of WOGF(FM), East Liverpool, Ohio, to prepare this statement and the attached Exhibit in support of a Petition to Amend the FM Table of Allotments, Section 73.202(b) of the FCC Rules and Regulations. The petitioner requests that Section 73.202(b) of the FCC Rules be modified in the following manner:

In accordance with the requested modifications to the FM Table of Allotments, the Petitioner requests that the license of station WOGF(FM) be modified to specify operation on channel 282B at Moon Township, Pennsylvania.

The instant Petition for Rulemaking will allow WOGF(FM) to provide a first local service to Moon Township, Pennsylvania (2000 population 22,290). Full service radio station WOHI(AM) [1490 kHz] will continue to provide local service to East Liverpool, Ohio.

An engineering study of all pertinent allotments, assignments and applications revealed that Channel 282B can be allotted to Moon Township, Pennsylvania, with a site restriction of 15.7 kilometers west. The allotment reference coordinates for Channel 282B at Moon Township, Pennsylvania are: 40° 30' 56" N.L. and 80° 24' 34" W.L. The Moon Township allotment reference site satisfies the city-grade coverage requirements of §73.315 of the FCC Rules. In addition, the Moon Township allotment reference site meets allotment standards and the minimum spacing requirements of §73.207 with respect to all pertinent protection requirements with the exception of first-adjacent channel, pre-1964, grandfathered short-spaced stations WQAL(FM), Cleveland, Ohio (Channel 281B) and WQKT(FM), Wooster, Ohio (Channel 283B).¹

The presently licensed WOGF(FM) transmitter site is short-spaced to first-adjacent channel pre-1964 grandfathered short-spaced station WQAL(FM) by 28.68 kilometers. The WOGF(FM) allocation reference site specified herein would be 22.8 kilometers short-spaced to WQAL(FM). Consequently, the proposed WOGF(FM), Moon Township,

allotment reference site would improve the WOGF/WQAL short-spacing by 5.88 kilometers.

Similarly, the presently licensed WOGF(FM) transmitter site is short-spaced to first-adjacent channel pre-1964 grandfathered short-spaced station WQKT(FM) by 41.52 kilometers. The WOGF(FM), Moon Township, allocation reference site specified herein would be 38.86 kilometers short-spaced to WQKT(FM). Consequently, the proposed WOGF(FM) allotment reference site would improve the WOGF/WQKT short-spacing by 2.66 kilometers.

In accordance with FCC precedent, WOGF(FM), an authorized "grandfathered" short-spaced FM station, is afforded the same opportunity to change its community of license as other stations authorized in conformity with FCC Rules.² Because the reference site proposed herein improves the short-spacings to both grandfathered short-spaced stations, reduces the interference potential between the stations and requests no change in Class, the proposed change in the WOGF(FM) community of license follows the precedent established in the proceedings cited in footnote 2.

Because the proposed Moon Township allotment reference site is 8.02 kilometers from the licensed WOGF(FM) transmitter site, the proposed reallocation would create a

WOGF gain area and a WOGF loss area. Considering a maximum Class B circle (52 km radius) the proposed reallocation would create a 834 km² gain area and a symmetrical 834 km² loss area, for no net gain or loss of service area. Both the gain area and the loss area are well-served by at least 5 aural services.

According to 2000 US Census data, the gain area population is 136,461 while there are 116,915 persons within the loss area. As a result, the proposed reallocation of WOGF(FM) will extend new 60 dBu service to an additional 19,546 persons.

According to 2000 Census data, Moon Township, Pennsylvania is within the 2,207 square kilometer, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, urbanized area (See Exhibit 1). Exhibit 1 also shows that a maximum Class 70 dBu circle (32.6 km radius) from the proposed Moon Township allotment reference site would cover 626 km², or 28.4%, of the Pittsburgh urbanized area. A maximum Class 70 dBu circle from the presently licensed WOGF(FM) transmitter site covers 567 km², or 25.7%, of the Pittsburgh urbanized area.

In addition, as shown on Exhibit 1, the licensed WOGF(FM) maximum Class B city-grade circle covers 89 km² (68%) of the 131 km² Weirton-Steubenville, OH-PA urbanized area, while the proposed Moon Township maximum Class B city-grade circle would cover 125 km² (95%) of the Weirton-Steubenville, OH-PA urbanized area.


Because the proposal would not cover at least 50% of the Pittsburgh urbanized area with a maximum Class B city-grade contour, and based on the present degree of coverage provided by WOGF(FM) to the Weirton-Steubenville urbanized area, a *Tuck* analysis (See

Faye and Richard Tuck, 3 FCC Rcd 5374 (1988)) is not required.³ Moon Township's community qualifications are demonstrated elsewhere in this Petition for Rulemaking.





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
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Moon Community Access Television
