Dear Ms. Dortch:

Yesterday afternoon, Mike Guerra, Martha Marcus and I, representing AT&T, Larry Fenster, representing MCI and Jeb Benedict, representing Sprint met with Dan Gonzalez from Commissioner Martin's office to discuss the above captioned matters.

Specifically, we indicated that the Commission should give the rules it provided in the SBR Order, in particular, the audit and reporting requirements, a chance to work before imposing additional requirements. We provided, for example, the IXC view that the collection of uncompleted call data and call duration data is not required.

In addition, we discussed the importance of allowing sufficient time for administrative and implementation activities associated with any change in the payphone dial-around compensation rate.
