The Dallas, Oregon Seventh-day Adventist Church (the "Church"), by counsel, hereby submits its Comments in support of the FCC's proposal in the above-identified proceeding to reserve FM Channel 252C3 at Dallas, Oregon for exclusive noncommercial use. The Commission has invited public comment on this proposal in its *Notice of Proposed Rulemaking*, DA 04-963, rel. April 14, 2004.


The Church was one of several parties to file a Petition for Rulemaking to propose this reservation of Channel 252C3 at Dallas. The Church supports the proposal and incorporates by reference its Petition in these Comments. If the Commission reserves Channel 252C3 at Dallas, Oregon for noncommercial use, the Church, or an affiliated entity, will file an application for a construction permit for a new noncommercial station on that channel. If its application is granted, the Church will promptly construct the new station and initiate a new broadcast service to Dallas, Oregon.
