Shaw, Executive Vice President and General Counsel of Charter Communications; Paul Glist and Chris Savage of Cole, Raywid & Braverman; and Al Mottur of Brownstein Hyatt Farber, met with Jordan Goldstein of Commissioner Copps' Office. Charter discussed the consequences of a federal mandate for a la carte offerings, including increased cost of cable service, loss of advertising revenues, billing complications, increased equipment cost for set-top boxes. It would also jeopardize the diversity of new and niche channels that rely upon tier placement.
