

On Wednesday, June 16, 2004, Christopher Cookson, President, Warner Bros. Technical Operations Inc. and Chief Technology Officer, Warner Bros. Entertainment Inc., Jill Lesser, Senior Policy Advisor, Time Warner Inc. and the undersigned, met separately with Jon Cody, legal advisor to Chairman Powell; Stacy Robinson Fuller, legal advisor to Commissioner Abernathy; Catherine Bohegian, legal advisor to Commissioner Martin; and Johanna Mikes Shelton, legal advisor to Commissioner Adelstein, to discuss issues related to the Commission's broadcast flag interim certification proceeding.
