On Wednesday June 30, 2004, Robert Foosaner, Chief Regulatory Officer of Nextel Communications (“Nextel”) spoke via telephone with John P. Muleta and Aaron Goldberger of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (“Bureau”) regarding the Commission’s above-referenced proceeding on public safety communications in the 800 MHz band.

Nextel discussed the filing of follow-up information by both Southern LINC and Nextel, in light of a joint meeting held by Southern LINC, Nextel and Bureau staff on June 25, 2004. The requested follow-up information was filed separately by Southern LINC and Nextel on June 30, 2004.¹
