T-Mobile suggested that, in its Notice of Proposed Rulemaking on remand from the U.S. Court of Appeals for the D.C. Circuit, the Commission should seek comment on whether the facilities between CMRS providers' cell sites and their mobile switching centers must be provided as unbundled network elements, pursuant to Section 251 of the Communications Act.
