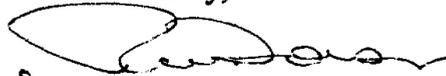
This letter responds to your request (dated March 24, 2004) submitted on behalf of Network Access Solutions Corporation (NAS) for waiver of the fiscal year (FY) 2003 regulatory fee and the associated late charge penalty for late payment of the regulatory fee. Our records reflect that NAS has not paid the \$18,088.88 FY 2003 regulatory fee or the \$4,522.22 late charge penalty.

You state that on June 4, 2002, NAS filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy in the United States Bankruptcy Court of the District of Delaware (Bankruptcy Court). In support, you submit a copy of NAS's Chapter 11 bankruptcy petition, dated June 4, 2002. You state that NAS remained in Chapter 11 bankruptcy on the date that the FY 2003 regulatory fee was due (i.e., September 25, 2003). You state that NAS "discontinued operations in January 2003 after selling its assets, including its customer accounts, to other carriers."¹

The Commission has determined that it will waive regulatory fees for licensees whose stations are bankrupt or are in receivership. See *Implementation of Section 9 of the Communications Act*, 10 FCC Rcd 12759, 12762 (1995). Accordingly, based upon the evidence you submit with respect to NAS's bankruptcy filing, your request for waiver of the FY 2003 regulatory fee and associated late charge penalty is granted and Bill number 04RE003338 will be cancelled.

Dear Ms. Pride:

This responds to your letter of February 19, 2004 to Network Access Solutions Corporation ("NAS") requesting payment of a fiscal year 2003 regulatory fee of \$18,088.88 and a penalty of \$4,522.22 for failure to pay by the 2003 regulatory fee payment deadline. For convenience, a copy of your February 19 letter is enclosed as Att. 1.

NAS had no obligation to pay a 2003 regulatory fee since the company discontinued operations in January 2003 after selling its assets, including its customer accounts, to other carriers.¹

Even if its shutdown shortly after fiscal 2003 began did not automatically relieve NAS from the obligation to pay a regulatory fee for that year (which it does), the company would be entitled to a waiver of the obligation to pay that fee since its January 2003 shutdown had followed the filing during FY 2002 of a voluntary petition for protection under the Federal Bankruptcy Code. A copy of NAS's bankruptcy petition, filed June 4, 2002, is attached as Att. 2. The Commission waives the obligation to pay regulatory fees

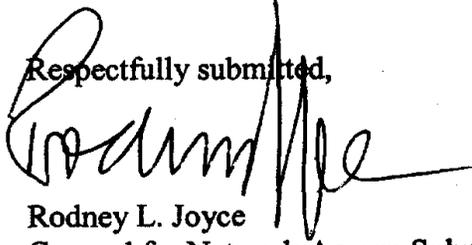

This letter is in reference to the Fiscal Year (FY) 2003 regulatory fees, which were due to the Federal Communications Commission (Commission) no later than September 26, 2003. These are mandatory fees established by Congress in accordance with the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1993. The fees are used to offset costs associated with the Commission's enforcement, public service, international policy, and rulemaking activities. An unpaid regulatory fee is a debt owed to the United States, see (31 U.S.C. §3701).

If the amount due is incorrect based on a revised FCC Form 499A submitted to NECA, please pay the newly calculated amount and pay this fee with the 25% penalty for this service.

Payment in full should be remitted with the enclosed Remittance Advice and FCC Form 159 to Federal Communications Commission, P.O. Box 358835, Pittsburgh, PA 15251-5835 within 30 days of the date of this letter. You should submit all payments that are due, including the 25% penalty, for each Filer ID and FRN. The payment type code for this service is 0372. The payment type code to be used for the penalty is 0399. Each payment type code should be listed separately on the Form 159.

If you made full payment within the time required, please provide a complete copy of your submission (Form 159), including proof of payment. If you believe that you were exempt from the FY 2003 regulatory fee under the Commission's rules, please submit complete documentation supporting your position within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. These documents should be sent to: Federal Communications Commission, Revenue & Receivables Operations Group, Room 1A821, 445 12th Street, SW, Washington, DC 20554.

We urge you to verify that proper payment was made to the Commission for this or any other Filer ID in past years. If you find that you were responsible for this payment but neglected to provide it in a past year, please remit those additional fees plus a 25% penalty before additional administrative action is undertaken.

You are cautioned that failure to respond and/or pay the penalty will subject you to further sanctions as defined by CFR Section 1.1164 of our Rules. These sanctions include subjecting the delinquent payer's pending applications to dismissal, and may require a delinquent payer to show cause why its existing instrument of authorization should not be revoked. Further sanctions include interest charges, and the full cost of collection to the Federal Government pursuant to Section 3720A of the Internal Revenue Code and the provisions of the Debt Collection Improvement Act of 1996.

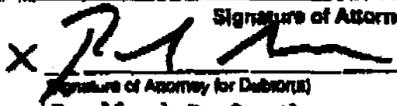
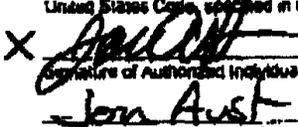
