
Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of the Newspaper Association of America ("NAA") and pursuant to Section 1.1206(b)(2) of the Commission's rules, we hereby submit this notice of a permitted oral *ex parte* presentation in the above-referenced proceeding.

On July 16, 2004, Richard E. Wiley and Kathleen A. Kirby of Wiley Rein & Fielding LLP met with FCC General Counsel John Rogovin, Deputy General Counsel Linda Kinney and Associate General Counsel Jacob Lewis. The meeting participants discussed the United States Court of Appeals decision in *Prometheus Radio Project v. Federal Communications Commission*, No. 03-3388, as it applies to newspaper/broadcast cross-ownership. On behalf of NAA, we urged the Commission to take action to lift the newspaper/broadcast cross-ownership ban in large markets consistent with the court's opinion.
