
Final TTY Status Report - CC Docket No. 94-102

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On June 28, 2002, Pine Belt Cellular, Inc. and Pine Belt PCS, Inc. (the "Pine Belt Carriers") filed a request for waiver of Section 20.18 of the Commission's rules and the June 30, 2002 deadline for compliance with the 911 Text Telephone ("TTY") obligations for digital wireless carriers ("Petition"). The Petition, as amended on January 15, 2003 and October 15, 2003, remains pending before the Commission. The Pine Belt Carriers report that they are now in compliance with Section 20.18 and the TTY obligations for digital wireless carriers. Accordingly, the Pine Belt Carriers respectfully request that the Commission dismiss the Petition. 


**PINE BELT CELLULAR, INC. & PINE BELT PCS, INC.**  
**FINAL TTY STATUS REPORT**  
**July 15, 2004**

Pine Belt Cellular, Inc. and Pine Belt PCS, Inc. (collectively "Pine Belt Wireless" or "Companies") requested waiver of the FCC's requirement for digital wireless carriers to obtain all software upgrades and equipment necessary to make their systems capable of transmitting 911 calls from TTY devices ("TTY Rules").<sup>1</sup> The Amended Petition seeks a temporary waiver of the TTY Rules until May 23, 2004.

Pine Belt Wireless reports that the necessary software feature has been installed and activated in its switch. Accordingly, the Companies believe that they are in compliance with the TTY Rules.
