



PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, Charles Crawford respectfully petitions the FCC to institute a Rule Making proceeding to amend the FM Table of Allotments to add Channel 285A at Cherokee, Texas.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 285A to Cherokee, Texas as that community's first local service. Cherokee, Texas is a community with a population of 175 people and 21 businesses that have been given a credit rating by Dun & Bradstreet as of the last quarter of 2000.<sup>1</sup> Cherokee, Texas has its own post office, volunteer fire

department, its own public school system, the Cherokee Elementary School and the Cherokee High School and a number of local churches. Civic pride and a sense of community identity is demonstrated by the fact that a number of business and organizations use the word Cherokee in their business title, such as: the Cherokee Grocery Store, the Cherokee Café, the Cherokee Retirement Home and the Cherokee Home for Children. Cherokee is a community that is certainly deserving of an FM service. The proposed channel 285A will provide additional diversity and an outlet for local self-expression to Cherokee residents and therefore is in the public interest.

Attached hereto is a channel study confirming that Channel 285A can be allocated to Cherokee, Texas, consistent with the FCC's FM separation rules. See revision of FM Assignment Policies and Procedures, 90 FCC 2d 88 (1992). (See, Attachment A) Note: pursuant to Report and Order, DA 03-3747, MB Docket o. 03-195, released November 26, 2003, station KXXS/ 285C2 at Marble Falls, Texas has been ordered to Channel 285A at Dripping Springs, Texas. (See, Attachment B)

Should this petition be granted and Channel 285A be allotted to Cherokee, Texas, Petitioner will apply for Channel 285A at Cherokee and after it is authorized, will promptly construct the new facility.





**REPORT AND ORDER**  
**(Proceeding Terminated)**

**Adopted: November 21, 2003**

**Released: November 26, 2003**

By the Assistant Chief, Audio Division:

1. In response to a Petition for Rule Making filed by Amigo Radio, Ltd. ("Amigo"), the Commission has before it for consideration the *Notice of Proposed Rule Making*,<sup>2</sup> requesting the substitution of Channel 285A for Channel 285C2 at Marble Falls, Texas, and reallocation of Channel 285A from Marble Falls, Texas, to Dripping Springs, Texas. Amigo also requests modification of the license for Station KXXS to specify Dripping Springs as the community of license. Amigo filed comments in which it restated its intention to file an application for Channel 285A at Dripping Springs. No other comments were received in response to the *Notice* in this proceeding.

2. Based upon the information presented in this proceeding, the public interest would be served by substituting Channel 285A for Channel 285C2 at Marble Falls and reallocating Channel 285A to Dripping Springs, Texas, since it would result in a preferential arrangement of allotments pursuant to the Commission's Change of Community procedures.<sup>3</sup> As stated in the *Notice*, information was provided demonstrating community status for Dripping Springs. Dripping Springs would receive its first local service fulfilling allotment priority (3) of the Commission's allotment priorities.<sup>4</sup> This

action will not deprive Marble Falls of local service as non-commercial Station KBMD, Channel 203A, will continue to provide service to the community. Retention of Channel 285C2 in Marble Falls would be considered under priority (4), other public interest matters.

3. The reallocation proposal is consistent with the requirements set forth in *Change of Community, supra*. As explained in the *Notice*, Dripping Springs is not located within an urbanized area.<sup>5</sup> Therefore information responsive to a *Tuck* analysis to determine whether Dripping Springs is sufficiently independent of an urbanized area to merit a first local service preference is not necessary.<sup>6</sup> Channel 285A can be allotted to Dripping Springs, Texas, in compliance with the Commission's minimum distance separation requirements at Amigo's specified site.<sup>7</sup> From this site, the gain area for Dripping Springs contains 107,518 people in an area of 459 square kilometers with a net loss of 226,000 people in an area of 6,049 square kilometers. Although there is a noticeable loss area, a staff engineering analysis confirms that the community of Marble Falls will continue to receive at least 16 aural services and that the entire loss area and population will receive five or more aural services. Further, 98 percent of the population within the loss area will receive ten or more aural services and no white or gray areas will be created with the channel reallocation which provides a first local service at Dripping Springs.<sup>8</sup> Both the loss and gain areas are considered to be well served with aural services. In accordance with Section 1.420(i) of the Commission's Rules, we will modify the license for Station KXXS to specify operation on Channel 285A at Dripping Springs, Texas, as its new community of license.

4. Accordingly, pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 4(i), 5(c)(1), 303(g) and (r) and 307(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Sections 0.61, 0.204(b) and 0.283 of the Commission's Rules, IT IS ORDERED, That effective January 12, 2004, the FM Table of

Therefore, operation with the facilities specified for Channel 285A at Dripping Springs is subject to modification, suspension, or termination without right to hearing, if found by the Commission to be necessary in order to conform to the 1992 USA-Mexico FM Broadcast Agreement or if specifically objected to by Mexico.

Allotments, Section 73.202(b) of the Commission's Rules, IS AMENDED for the communities listed below, as follows:

5. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That pursuant to Section 316(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, that the license of Amigo Radio, Ltd. for Station KXXS, Channel 285C2, Marble Falls, Texas, IS MODIFIED to specify operation on Channel 285A at Dripping Springs, Texas, subject to the following conditions:

(a) Within 90 days of the effective date of the *Order*, the licensee of Station KXXS shall submit to the Commission a minor change application for a construction permit (Form 301), specifying the new facility;

(b) Upon grant of the construction permit, program tests may be conducted in accordance with Section 73.1620; and

(c) Nothing contained herein shall be construed to authorize a change in transmitter location or to avoid the necessity of filing an environmental assessment pursuant to Section 1.1307 of the Commission's Rules, unless the proposed facilities are categorically excluded from environmental processing.

6. Pursuant to Commission Rule Section 1.1104(1)(k) and (2)(k), any party seeking a change in community of license of an FM or television allotment or an upgrade of an existing FM allotment, IF THE REQUEST IS GRANTED, must submit a rule making fee when filing its application to implement the change in community of license and/or upgrade. As a result of this proceeding, Amigo Radio, Ltd., licensee of Station KXXS, Channel 285C2, is required to submit a rule making fee in addition to the fee required for the application to effectuate the change in community of license and class change for Station KXXS, from Channel 285C2 to Channel 285A and reallocation of the channel from Marble Falls, Texas, to Dripping Springs, Texas.

7. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That this proceeding IS TERMINATED.
