

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Miller Telephone Company ("MTC") submits this letter and accompanying certification as record that MTC is not a "Completing Carrier" as that term is defined in the Commission's Order in CC Docket 96-128 ("Order")¹, released on October 3, 2003, respecting the obligations of such Completing Carriers to provide certain compensation and reporting to payphone service providers (PSPs), and replacing the Commission's interim compensation rules effective July 1, 2004.

As MTC is not a Completing Carrier nor does it handle the types of calls the Commission has specified as being subject to both compensation and reporting to PSPs, MTC is not subject to such requirements at this time. If MTC'S operations are altered to the extent that MTC necessarily becomes a Completing Carrier, MTC intends to fully comply with the Commission's rules pertaining to this and all other payphone compensation and reporting matters.
