On behalf of United States Cellular Corporation ("USCC"), pursuant to the request of John B. Muleta, Chief Wireless Telecommunications Bureau ("WTB"), and Martin K. Perry, Chief Economist of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") to Mr. James R. Jenkins, Vice President – Legal and External Affairs dated July, 16, 2004 (the "Informational Request"), we are writing to inform you that we have today delivered by hand to Susan Singer of the WTB the response of USCC to the Informational Request. As discussed with Ms. Singer today, USCC intends to supplement its response, in particular to respond to Items 2(d) and 2(e), next week, by August 6, 2005.
