

I am requesting that the FCC in its development of VOIP regulations include the following:

1. mandate that telephone numbers used by VOIP be listed in local telephone directories and 411 information service, upon the request of the subscriber;
2. provide for VOIP service to be offered to subscribers with 2 different telephone numbers in the home without having to pay for and install a 2nd cable modem;
3. provide that telephone companies offer an extended referral message, for a fee, past the currently available 30 day time period (i.e., when a consumer changes from MCI to Cablevision and their phone number is changed because no number portability is available, the message that MCI plays when the old number is called should be available for an extended time, since the new number is unlisted by the cable provider);
4. mandate telephone number portability when consumers switch from a telephone carrier (i.e. MCI) to a VOIP service (i.e. Cablevision).
