Dear Madam Secretary:

In accordance with Section 64.1120(e) of the Commission's Rules, this letter provides notification of the transfer of ICOM, Inc. local exchange customers in New York and Rhode Island to Verizon.

ICOM, Inc. has ceased providing telecommunications service to its customers in New York and Rhode Island, where Verizon is the default carrier. To prevent disconnection of these customers, Verizon will begin providing service to these customers shortly, once Verizon receives a final list of defaulted customers. Verizon will also provide the notifications required by Section 64.1120(e) as soon as the Commission grants Verizon's petition for waiver of the 30-day advance notice requirement, which was filed concurrently with this letter in CC Docket 00-257.
