

Proponents original petition.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public
interest would be served by allocating Channel 281A to
Rosepine, Louisiana as that community's first local
service. Rosepine, Louisiana is an incorporated community
with a population of 1,135 people. Rosepine has its own
mayor, Johnny B. Hall, its own post office, volunteer fire
department, police department, Chief of Police James
Parrott, its own high school, elementary school and several
local churches. Rosepine is a community that is certainly
deserving of local FM service. The proposed channel 281A
will provide additional diversity and an outlet for local

self-expression to Rosepine residents and therefore is in the public interest.

Should this petition be granted and Channel 281A allotted to Rosepine, Louisiana, Petitioner will apply for Channel 281A at Rosepine and after it is authorized, will promptly construct the new facility.
