**ENFORCEMENT BUREAU'S REQUEST FOR

The Enforcement Bureau, pursuant to section 1.246 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.246, hereby requests that, within ten (10) days of service of this Request, San Francisco Unified School District ("SFUSD") admit to the truth of the following facts and genuineness of the attached documents, as set forth in the following numbered paragraphs. Each response shall be labeled with the same number as the subject admission request and shall be made under oath or affirmation of the person providing the response. SFUSD, as defined below, is reminded that "[a] denial shall fairly meet the substance of the requested admission, and when good faith requires that a party deny only a part or a qualification of a matter of which an admission is requested, he shall specify so much of it as true and deny only the remainder." 47 CFR § 1.246(b).

Definitions

For this document, the following definitions apply:

"SFUSD" means San Francisco Unified School District, any d/b/a, and each of its members during the period January 1, 1991 to the present.

"Mr. Ramirez" means Mr. Jeffrey Ramirez.

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ATG

"Mr. Rojas" means Mr. Waldemar Rojas.

"Mr. Helgeson" means Mr. William Helgeson.

"Ms. Hecht" means Ms. Susen (or Susan) Hecht.

"Mr. Sanchez" means Mr. Ernest T. Sanchez, an attorney who has represented and continues to represent SFUSD, the Sanchez Law Firm, and any employee thereof.

"False" with respect to an answer to a question appearing on an FCC application, means incorrect or inaccurate, without regard to the intent of the person or persons who answers the question and/or signs the application.

"KALW" means radio broadcast station KALW(FM), San Francisco, California.

The "Commission" or the "FCC" means the Federal Communications Commission and any employee thereof.

Admissions Requests

1. Attachment A is a true and accurate copy of the application filed at the FCC on behalf of SFUSD for renewal of license for KALW (File No. BRED-19970801YA).
2. Mr. Ramirez oversaw preparation of the original of Attachment A.
3. At the time that he oversaw preparation of the original of Attachment A, Mr. Ramirez was general manager of KALW.

A to a representative of SFUSD for signature, Mr. Ramirez knew that the KALW public inspection file did not include the original or a copy of Attachment C.

15. Attachment D is a true and accurate copy of the SFUSD 1995 Supplemental Report (From KALW Public Inspection File), which appeared as an attachment in a letter dated April 5, 2001, from Mr. Sanchez to Linda Blair, Chief, Audio Services Division, Mass Media Bureau, FCC.
16. On or about the date that Mr. Ramirez transmitted the original of Attachment A to a representative of SFUSD for signature, the KALW public inspection file did not include the original or a copy of Attachment D.
17. On or about the date that Mr. Ramirez transmitted the original of Attachment A to a representative of SFUSD for signature, Mr. Ramirez knew that the KALW public inspection file did not include the original or a copy of Attachment D.
18. On or about the date that Mr. Ramirez transmitted the original of Attachment A to a representative of SFUSD for signature, the KALW public inspection file did not include the original or a copy of all of the quarterly issues/programs lists required by 47 C.F.R. Section 73.3527.
19. On or about the date that Mr. Ramirez transmitted the original of Attachment A to a representative of SFUSD for signature, Mr. Ramirez knew that the KALW public inspection file did not include the original or a copy of all of the quarterly issues/programs lists required by 47 C.F.R. Section 73.3527.
20. Mr. Rojas, or someone who had authority to do so, signed his name to the

original of Attachment A on page 5 on or about July 30, 1997.

21. In so signing Mr. Rojas's name to the original of Attachment A, SFUSD intended to certify that the statements in the application were true, complete and correct to the best of its knowledge and belief, and were made in good faith.
22. On or about July 30, 1997, Mr. Rojas had no personal knowledge as to whether SFUSD had placed in the KALW public inspection file at the appropriate times the documentation required by 47 C.F.R. Section 73.3527.
23. On or about July 30, 1997, Mr. Ramirez knew that SFUSD had not placed in the KALW public inspection file at the appropriate times the documentation required by 47 C.F.R. Section 73.3527.
24. On or about July 30, 1997, the KALW public inspection file was located in Mr. Helgeson's office at KALW.
25. Prior to July 30, 1997, Mr. Helgeson provided assistance to update and maintain the KALW public inspection file.



The applicant is a large public entity and political subdivision of the State of California. The applicant has more than 4,000 employees and 62,000 students under its jurisdiction. Consequently, the applicant is engaged in a considerable amount of litigation. Since 1990, there have been a handful of administrative agency decisions concluding that the applicant engaged in discrimination against an individual employee. There have been no similar court decisions.

Administrative actions against the District (e.g., Department of Education's Office of Civil Rights; Equal Employment Opportunity Commission) are not logged in a fashion which would enable the District to identify a particular proceeding or dispute. Consequently, the information you are requesting cannot be provided. However, none of the very few administrative determinations have involved KALW or its employees.
