

04-151      Unlicensed Use of the 3650-3700 MHz Band

My message to this NPRM is simple. I support the NPRM for the unlicensed use of the 3650-3700 MHz band. I am one of thousands of WISPs who are working as hard as we can to bring high speed wireless broadband access to rural areas where other broadband access is not available. We use the frequencies we are allowed to use to the point that we often have overcrowding of the bands allotted. I would like to see the unlicensed use of the 3650-3700 MHz band. I would also like to see this band allocated for channel plans that allow a maximum of 6 MHz of use per radio channel as to maintain re-use of this band. Without channel size limitations it is possible for radio manufacturers to make the band unusable by using the entire band for one radio link. This is inefficient and should be discouraged.
