Dear Ms. Dortch:

On Wednesday, September 1, 2004, Michael Ha and I of Nextel Communications spoke with Uzoma Onyeije, Tom Stanley, Peter Corea, John Spencer, Peter Trachtenberg, Nese Guendelsberger, and Marty Liebman of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. We reiterated Nextel's previously stated positions in this proceeding and stressed that licensees can use the proposed H Block channels without causing harmful interference. Nextel explained that the Commission can adopt reasonable operating parameters to assure that H Block use does not interfere with other licensed operations in adjacent spectrum blocks. Prospective H Block auction participants can and will take these parameters into account in their bidding decisions.
