The meeting covered matters relating to the scope and interpretation of paragraph 74 the Order released August 12, 2004 in *In the Matter of Digital Output Protection Technology and Recording Method Certifications*, MB Docket 04-64, particularly with respect to the localization requirement for DTCP-IP, and the interoperability between source devices with DTCP-IP "RTT" localization and downstream devices that may, prior to the effective date of the updated DTCP-IP Specification, be manufactured employing DTCP-IP without such "RTT" localization.

In addition, DTLA confirmed that the obligation to notify the Commission of material changes to the protection technology, as set forth generally in the Order, would not extend generally to notification of any amendments to the protocols for the interfaces to which DTCP has been mapped, except insofar as any amendments would affect the protection functions of DTCP.
