On September 17, 2004, Thomas Sugrue and Jamie Hedlund, T-Mobile USA, Inc., and Ruth Milkman of Lawler, Metzger & Milkman, counsel to T-Mobile, met with Thomas Navin, Jeremy Miller, Russ Hanser, Ian Dillner, Gail Cohen, Tim Stelzig, Carol Simpson, and Marcus Maher to discuss the above-captioned proceeding. During the meeting, T-Mobile explained the importance of ensuring that wireless carriers have nondiscriminatory access to unbundled network elements, which are critical to the ability of wireless carriers to compete with incumbent local exchange carriers. The discussion was consistent with T-Mobile's previous written submissions in CC Docket No. 01-338, and the attached network diagram.


