Today, Jeff Lindsey and I met with Matthew Brill to discuss intercarrier compensation for ISP-bound traffic. Consistent with its filings in this proceeding, Sprint urged that the growth and new market restrictions be lifted, and that the mirroring requirement be maintained, and discussed ways of preventing an increase in total ISP outpayments. Sprint also cautioned that whatever legal justification is used in the *ISP Remand* proceeding should be carefully crafted to preserve the Commission's ability to later adopt a unified intercarrier compensation regime for all telecommunications traffic.
