Cingular Wireless Corporation (“Cingular”) hereby responds to the request of Kaplan Telephone Company d/b/a PACE Communications (“Kaplan”)¹ for Commission approval to withdraw its Informal Objection and Request for Commission Action.² As required by Section 1 935(b), attached is a certification that:

Cingular and its principals have not paid, and will not pay, any money to Kaplan for the withdrawal of its informal objection (“Objection”) to the merger. The withdrawal was based solely on the execution of an Addendum to the parties existing Switching Services Agreement. The Addendum was attached to Kaplan’s Motion to Withdraw and resolved a private contractual dispute that formed the basis of the Objection.

The sole consideration for Kaplan’s withdrawal is described in, and attached to, the Motion. AT&T Wireless Services, Inc., the other applicant in the referenced proceeding, was not a party to the negotiations.


