This letter is to inform you that on October 13, 2004, Scott Freiermuth and Kevin Butler, representing Sprint Corporation, met with Greg Guice of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, to discuss Sprint's positions regarding the outstanding Petition for Reconsideration in the above-referenced proceeding.

Sprint discussed the need to modify the order to allow for compliance flexibility and some of its concerns with the compliance due date. Finally, Sprint urged the Commission to enforce its HAC rules and to remove its delegation of enforcement authority to the states.
