





History

City

Burlingame is the oldest surviving city in Osage County. It was founded in 1854 by settlers from Pennsylvania traveling on the Santa Fe Trail. Ruts from the wagons on the trail can still be seen about four miles west of Burlingame on Highway 31.

Burlingame

is located in Osage County at the junction of US Highway 56 and State Highway 31 where the old Santa Fe Trail crosses the Santa Fe Railroad.




As you enter Santa Fe Avenue, known as main street to the townspeople now, you will notice the extra wide street. The 130 foot street allows for cars to park on the sides and in the middle. The streets were made this wide to accommodate the Santa Fe Trail which went down the main street, allowing the large oxen teams pulling covered wagons to make a "U -Turn". Santa Fe Avenue was laid with the red bricks in the 1920's, and is still covered with bricks to this day.

The Santa Fe railroad construction began in Topeka in October 1868 and reached Burlingame in 1869. Each run between the two towns was 28 miles and about 2 and a half hours each way. In the first year of operation the Santa Fe Railway carried 33,628 passengers, hauled 98,917 tons of freight, had two locomotives, two coaches, one baggage car, and 36 freight cars. By the end of 1870 the Santa Fe had completed tracks through Osage County.

City Council

City

Burlingame has a Mayor-Council type government. Meetings are scheduled the 1st and 3rd Mondays of each month at 7:00 p.m. and are held in the Council Chamber of City Hall. The Mayor presides at all meetings of the City Council and recommends measures he deems advisable. The Mayor has the power to appoint all members to City Boards with the consent of the majority of the Council members. The Mayor votes on Council business only in case of a tie vote and has the power to sign or veto any ordinance passed by the Council.


The City Clerk should be notified by the Wednesday preceding each meeting for placement on the agenda. A Public Open Forum is a permanent part of the agenda for an individual to speak with the Council for a period of 10 minutes provided no Council action is required.

The mayor is elected for a two year term and the five council members are elected to four year terms. This governing body continues to make it a progressive city capable of generating its own power and they have secured a permanent water supply. We are proud of the progress and growth the city has undertaken the past few years.


a Saturday, the city will observe that day on Friday. If the holiday falls on a Sunday, the city will observe that day on Monday.

The City provides electric, water, gas, sewer and trash. Bills are mailed monthly and are payable upon receipt and delinquent after 5:00pm on the 15th day of the following month unless the 15th shall be a Saturday, Sunday or City Holiday, in which event payment shall be due by 5:00pm on the next business day.

Trash collection is now being done by Aard's Trash Service. Residential pickup is Tuesdays, Business pickup is Tuesdays and Fridays. Outside City limit customers with City Utilities will be picked up on Fridays. Trash needs to be set out by 7:30 a.m. the day of pickup. Large items will be picked up for an addition charge. 

Fire Department

City

The Burlingame Fire Department is a full service fire department that serves the City of Burlingame as well as Burlingame and Dragoon Townships.



History

The city fathers back in 1876 formed the original fire department which has been in force to this day. The department has always been manned by an all volunteer membership. The original organization started out with one piece of equipment, that being a hose cart that was pulled to the fire by hand. Over the years the department acquired motorized equipment.

Up until 1958 the fire department only responded to alarms inside the city limits. That same year the City of Burlingame joined together with Dragoon and Burlingame Townships to form a larger department and provide fire protection to the entire area. Shortly after that time a new radio system was installed to better alert the fire fighters when there was a fire call.

In the late 1970's another volunteer group started the Rescue Squad which would respond to emergency medical calls. This group was completely donation funded and staffed by some members from the fire department as well as their own charter members. This group served a very important and appreciated service to the community and paved the way for our First Responder Program that we have today. In 1987 the Rescue Squad became a part of the fire department and is now supported by funds from within the fire department budget.

the days of a hand drawn hose cart to two class A pumper trucks, a 1250 gallon tanker, two brush trucks and a rescue truck. We are equipped with a full set of hydraulic rescue tools ("Jaws of Life"), as well as an automatic defibrillator to assist with heart attack victims. The equipment is housed in our fire station at the intersection of Lincoln and Dacotah streets.

Some types of emergencies the department responds to are house fires, car fires, grass and brush fires, hazardous material calls, carbon monoxide alarms, vehicle accidents and, of course the most requested, emergency medical calls. They respond to an average of 200 calls per year.


The ISO rates which determines fire insurance rates are classes 7-9.

The department is still manned by 25 all-volunteer personnel who meet twice a month for regular training drills as well as spending numerous hours maintaining fire equipment. Their members have attended outside training courses to become state certified Emergency Medical Technicians.



The Burlingame City Animal Control is open for reclaiming and adopting out dogs from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. Unclaimed animals can be adopted on the 3rd day after being picked up.

If we have your dog or you would like to adopt one, please call City Hall at 785.654.2414 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. Annual Dog Tags are due January 1st of each year and available at City Hall. Please bring the current proof of rabies vaccination with you.

The Burlingame City Animal Control is responsible for promoting public health and safety, for temporarily sheltering and providing humane disposition of unwanted or lost animals, and for promoting animal welfare so that pet ownership is a pleasure for owners without becoming a burden to the community.

Any animal that bites a person must be destroyed and tested for rabies or held for a ten day observation period at the city's pound or an animal hospital. Impounding, room and board fees are charged.

Animal Control also disposes of dead animals for City residents.

Burlingame has one public school, USD 454, which includes Pre-12th grades. The newly renovated elementary and high school sections offer exemplary educational opportunities for their students.



The 130 foot width of Santa Fe Street dates from the time of the Santa Fe Trail and allowed ox teams to turn around. It was covered with brick and concrete in 1922.




