COMMENTS IN SUPPORT OF RULEMAKING

Arkansas Educational Television Commission ("AETC"), by its attorneys and pursuant to the Commission's Rules, comments on the above-referenced rulemaking proceeding to amend Section 73.622(b) of the Rules. The rulemaking proposes to amend the Commission's Rules by substituting DTV channel *12 for DTV channel *30 at El Dorado, Arkansas.

AETC initiated this proceeding and reaffirms its interest in applying for DTV channel *12 at El Dorado, if allotted. If authorized to do so, AETC will promptly build this station on the requested channel. AETC hereby incorporates by reference the showings made in its *Petition for Rulemaking* in this proceeding, as filed with the FCC on May 19, 2004, and supplemented on June 23, 2004.

For these reasons and those expressed in the prior *Petition*, AETC supports the rulemaking proceeding to amend Section 73.622(b) of the Commission's Rules to substitute DTV channel *12 for DTV channel *30 at El Dorado, Arkansas.


