JOINT STATUS REPORT

The Enforcement Bureau (the "Bureau") and San Francisco Unified School District ("SFUSD," and collectively with the Bureau, the "Parties"), by their counsel, hereby submit this Joint Status Report pursuant to and in conformance with the Presiding Officer's *Order*, FCC 04M-24, released September 10, 2004.

1. Status of Discovery: Six depositions were taken in San Francisco during the week of September 27, 2004. The deposition of Jeffrey Ramirez, former General Manager of KALW is scheduled for November 9, 2004, in D.C. At present, the Bureau is considering noticing the deposition in D.C. of one additional individual. SFUSD has responded to and has filed a supplemental response to the Bureau's Interrogatories; the Presiding Officer has dismissed as moot the Bureau's September 21, 2004 Motion to Compel. SFUSD has responded to and has filed a revised response to the Bureau's Requests for Admission of Facts and Genuiness of Documents; the Presiding Officer has ruled on the Bureau's September 24, 2004 Motion to Rule on Objections and Denials to Admission Requests. SFUSD has responded to the Bureau's First Request for Production of Documents. SFUSD intends to file a supplement to the Document Request within the next 10 days.

Stipulation on Relevant Time Period: The Parties agree that the relevant time period at issue in this license renewal proceeding begins on January 1, 1991, the date the current license term began (following the grant on December 31, 1990 of the prior license renewal application). The Parties are not in agreement as to the termination date.


¹ Depending on the degree and type of evidence, the Presiding Officer may deem that an Admission session is not necessary.


