
Re: *Vonage Petition for Declaratory Ruling*, WC Docket No. 03-211; *IP-Enabled Services*, WC Docket No. 04-36

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On Tuesday, 26 October 2004, Paula Boyd and Pierre De Vries of Microsoft, and undersigned counsel, Microsoft met with Jeffrey Carlisle, Robert Tanner, Christi Shrewman, Jeremy Miller, Julie Veach and Pamela Arluk of the Wireline Competition Bureau with respect to the above-captioned proceedings. Microsoft's presentation was consistent with its comments filed in Docket No. 04-36, and supported an FCC finding that Vonage's service – and similar services – are interstate in nature. Microsoft also suggested that any regulation of voice services using IP ought to be limited only to those services which are marketed, and used by consumers, as a substitute for traditional PSTN services.
