

PETITIONER'S COMMENTS

Please accept these comments as restated below from
Proponents original petition.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public
interest would be served by allocating Channel 222A to
Boyce, Louisiana as that community's first competing FM
service.¹ Boyce, Louisiana is an incorporated city with a
population of 1,190 people.² Boyce has its own mayor,
Julius Patrick, Jr., its own post office, volunteer fire
department, police department, Chief of Police Claude E.
William, city offices and a number of local churches.
Boyce is a community that is certainly deserving of a

second local FM service. The proposed channel 222A will provide additional diversity and an outlet for local self-expression to Boyce residents and therefore is in the public interest.
