Dear Ms. Dortch:

This is to report that representatives of Comcast Corporation ("Comcast") discussed the above-captioned proceeding in brief telephone conversations on November 1 with Christopher Libertelli, Senior Advisor to Chairman Powell, and on November 2 with Michelle Carey, Deputy Chief of the Wireline Competition Bureau. In the first conversation, Comcast was represented by James R. Coltharp, Comcast's Chief Policy Advisor, FCC & Regulatory Policy, and the undersigned. In the second, Comcast was represented solely by the undersigned.

Consistent with the comments and reply comments filed by Comcast in May and July, we urged the Commission to establish as much regulatory certainty as possible, as promptly as possible, for Voice over Internet Protocol ("VoIP") services. We also reiterated Comcast's view that the Commission should act in ways that do not disadvantage facilities-based providers of VoIP services.
