



This is a Request of Review of a decision made by Universal Service Administrative Company on the Funding Commitment Report dated October 15, 2004.

Applicant: St. Martin De Porres School

Funding was denied because the school was unable to provide sufficient documentation to determine the eligibility of this item.

On the above report the only services ordered from Novacon were T1 internet services. The school had received funding for this item previously in 2000, and since in 2003 (the school forgot to apply in 2002). The school promptly paid their 10% throughout the 2001 school year.

When we questioned the school, they always told us an appeal had been filed, and denied.

We recently determined that the appeal was for infrastructure services from another vendor, whose work was totally unrelated to our internet services. It appears all funding requests by the school were denied in 2001 based on the large proposals for the infrastructure upgrade.

Our records show that your appeal was postmarked more than 60 days after the date your Funding Commitment Decision Letter being appealed was issued, as shown above.
