Hearing Aid Compatibility Report

Iowa RSA No. 2 Limited Partnership d/b/a Lyrix Wireless (“Lyrix Wireless”), by its attorneys, pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission’s (“Commission” or “FCC”) *Order* in WT Docket No. 01-309,^{1/} and the subsequent *Public Notice* in the same proceeding,^{2/} hereby files its Second Report detailing its efforts towards compliance with the FCC’s hearing aid compatibility requirements. Lyrix Wireless is including in its Second Report all information of which it has knowledge, but does not address those reporting requirements in the *Order* that can be adequately answered only by the individual handset manufacturers.

I. Carrier Background

Lyrix Wireless is a small Commercial Mobile Radio Services carrier that provides analog and digital service using CDMA technology in the Iowa 2 – Union RSA, under FCC call sign KNKN492.

II. Handsets Currently Offered for Sale

Lyrix Wireless currently offers for sale handsets manufactured by LG, Motorola, Kyocera and Nokia. The specific handset models are the LG VX10 and VX4400; Motorola 310, C343 and V60s; Kyocera 3225, 3245, 3586i, Blade, Phantom and Slider; and the Nokia 3586i.

Based on conversations with the manufacturer of each handset that Lyrix Wireless currently offers for sale, none of the phones Lyrix Wireless has been able to obtain from its third party vendor meet the Commission’s hearing aid compatibility requirements at this time.

However, Lyrix Wireless does offer hands-free neck loop accessories to allow for conversation by users with telecoil-compatible hearing aids.

III. Hearing Aid Compatible Handset Labeling/Insert Requirement

None of the handsets that Lyrix Wireless has available for sale to its subscribers have a label attached on the handset's packaging indicating the U-rating of the wireless telephone. None of the handset packaging contains inserts describing the U-rating system.

IV. Outreach Efforts

Lyrix Wireless intends to educate its subscribers, and any potential subscribers, on the functionality of any of the hearing aid compatible handsets it is able to obtain.
