Dear Ms. Dortch:

This is to inform you that representatives of AirCell, Inc. ("AirCell") participated in *ex parte* meetings on November 22, 2004 to discuss issues in the above-referenced air-to-ground ("ATG") proceeding. Specifically, Jack Blumenstein, Chairman and CEO, Bill Gordon, VP for Government Affairs, and I, counsel to AirCell, participated in two meetings with: (1) Commissioner Michael Copps and his legal advisor Paul Margie; and (2) Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein and his senior legal advisor Barry Ohlson.

During the two meetings, AirCell reviewed the attached presentation, focusing on the importance of providing for competition in the ATG band and the resulting benefits to passengers. AirCell also expressed concern that the possibility of providing ancillary terrestrial services in the ATG band could influence auction bidding strategies. Finally, AirCell provided copies of and briefly discussed the attached response to Nextel's November 16 filing regarding the need for appropriate out-of-band emission limits in the ATG band.
