On November 29, 2004, I met with Jonathan Cody, Media Advisor to FCC Chairman Michael Powell. During the meeting we discussed the following issues.

On behalf of MSTV, I outlined the basic elements of the "Unified Broadcast Plan" that was filed with the FCC on October 29, 2004. I also presented Mr. Cody with a letter of additional support that was filed by broadcasters on November 4, 2004. Both documents were filed previously in the Commission's record.

I also presented to Mr. Cody our interference concerns regarding the application of ALOHA Partners to operate wideband wireless services in Tucson, Arizona. I provided Mr. Cody with copies of *MSTV's Reply Comments and Informal Objection* (August 17, 2004) and *Reply of the Association for Maximum Service Television, Inc.* (September 23, 2004). These documents were filed previously in the Commission's record in this proceeding.
