
Dear Ms. Dortch:

Carlos Nalda of The Boeing Company ("Boeing") and the undersigned on behalf of Boeing met on December 6, 2004, with Sheryl Wilkerson, legal advisor to Chairman Powell, and on December 7, 2004, accompanied by Beverly Wyse of Boeing, met with Commissioner Adelstein and his legal advisor Barry Ohlson, and Commissioner Martin and his legal advisor Sam Feder regarding the above-captioned proceeding. We presented arguments in support of licensing two broadband providers in the air-to-ground ("ATG") band, as set out in Boeing's prior filings in this proceeding, and expressed concern that the grant of terrestrial ancillary use rights would enhance the incumbent narrowband ATG provider's chances of becoming the sole provider of broadband ATG service.
