Dear Ms. Dortch:

This is to inform you that, on December 13, 2004, in connection with the above-referenced applications, the undersigned, representing Motient, Inc., an investor in Mobile Satellite Ventures LP ("MSV"), spoke by telephone to Don Abelson, Chief of the International Bureau.

The purpose of the call was to emphasize the importance of the Commission's resolving the Ancillary Terrestrial Component ("ATC") issues remaining after the issuance of the International Bureau's ATC licensing decision.¹ I also characterized Inmarsat's recently-filed Application for Review of the ATC licensing order as an attempt to obstruct implementation a viable next-generation MSS system by MSV.
