Dear Madam Secretary:

On December 1, 2004, SES Americom, Inc. ("SES") submitted a letter to the Commission giving notice that the assignment of certain of the licenses covered by the above-referenced applications -- including both earth station and terrestrial wireless licenses -- had been consummated ("Notice Letter").¹ Exhibit A to the Notice Letter listed the licenses that had been assigned to SES. Exhibit B to the Notice Letter listed various earth stations and wireless licenses (for facilities associated with the Cedar Hill, Texas teleport and related video distribution network) that had not been assigned to SES, but instead were to be assigned to a third party upon receipt of Commission approval for same (the "Cedar Hill Licenses").²

¹ A duplicate notification covering the wireless licenses involved in the transaction was filed with the ULS system.

² On December 17, 2004, Verestar, Inc. (Debtor-in-Possession) filed applications seeking consent to the assignment of the various earth station (FCC Form 312) and wireless (FCC Form 603) licenses listed in Exhibit B to the Notice Letter (plus others) to Cedar Hill Texas Video Network LP ("CHTVN"). KA96423 was among the Cedar Hill Licenses specified for assignment to CHTVN.



We recently discovered that the Commission mistakenly assigned to SES a Local Television Transmission Service license -- call sign KA86423 -- that Exhibit B of the Notice Letter specified should not be assigned to SES. SES respectfully requests that the Commission rescind its erroneous assignment such that the Commission will be in a position to consider instead the pending application to assign KA86423 and the other Cedar Hill Licenses to CHTVN.
